Dear Parent/Carer

As I am sure you are now aware, the majority of pupils will be learning from home until at least February half term following yesterday's Government announcement.

The Department of Education have today confirmed that the Year 11 examinations taking place next week are going ahead as planned. Mrs Arshad will provide you with arrangements in due course and pupils should continue to revise in preparation.

The official Department of Education guidance for summer examinations states that the Government do not think that it will be possible for exams to take place as they would normally. However, I would like to stress to Year 11 pupils and their parents that the qualifications will still be awarded through a form of assessment that will be confirmed shortly. Therefore, pupils should still endeavour to study hard towards the completion of these courses by completing all work set by teachers.

As we are now moving towards an extended period of remote learning, in order to improve the education your son receives at home, over the coming weeks we will move away from the way that work is currently set, to a schedule of live lessons for all year groups.
